Proposed Activities on the Road Corridor Bylaw 2022

Kia ora,

We are writing to you as we think you may be interested in our public consultation for a proposed bylaw. We wish to inform you of our proposal and seek your input. Based on your field of work and previous dealings with Auckland Transport (AT) and Auckland Council, you may be impacted by this bylaw change.

AT is proposing the **Activities in the Road Corridor Bylaw (2022)**, to consolidate five former bylaws which regulate various special uses of the roads across Tāmaki Makaurau. We have reached the public consultation phase of this bylaw's development, and we want to hear from you.

The new bylaw should streamline processes and ensure activities across the road corridor are done so legally and safely. Your views and industry experience are integral in achieving a refined bylaw which is fit for purpose.

This bylaw is about managing special uses of the road. The proposed changes will impact the following activities on the road corridor:

- Roadworks and construction, including vehicle crossings
- Events, filming, and trading
- Livestock movement and grazing

Our aim is to make the process of issuing licences more comprehensive and easier for applicants, and to define our management and enforcement approach for these activities.

Attached to this email you will find some information about the new bylaw in development, and how the changes may affect you. We are holding online Q&A sessions on January 27, conducting industry specific focus groups, and collecting feedback through an online survey. Please follow the link below for dates and details.

If you require any further information, please contact us. We encourage you to share your views, your input is carefully considered. The finalised bylaw may impact how you do things in the future - This is your opportunity to tell us your priorities.
